## Who Can Enrol?

Carbal's CAT has two parallel courses to target specific audiences and meet national accreditation standards:

### Competent CAT:

Businesses, Community Organisations, Government Departments & Agencies, Individuals

### Clinical CAT:

General Practice, Health Professionals, Clinic Staff



## Course Duration

Carbal CAT is an 8-hour online learning package. The entire course is required to be completed within 3 months of enrolling.

# CAT for General Practice

## Clinical CAT & Commonwealth Financial Incentives

The Practice Incentives Program (PIP) Indigenous Health Incentive (IHI) aims to support general practice to better manage chronic disease in Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander patients. The PIP IHI gives accredited practices annual incentives when they register these patients who have a chronic disease.

One of the PIP IHI requirements states that at least 2 staff members undertake cultural awareness training one of whom must be a GP.

## The PIP IHI has 3 Components:

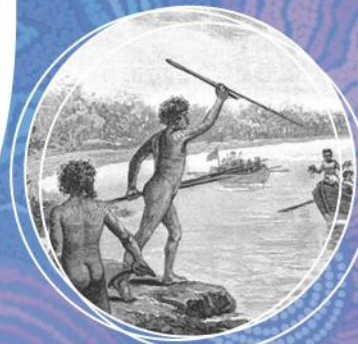
- \$1000 sign on payment
- \$150 patient registration payment (per patient per year)
- \$250 Outcomes payment (up to \$250 per patient per year)

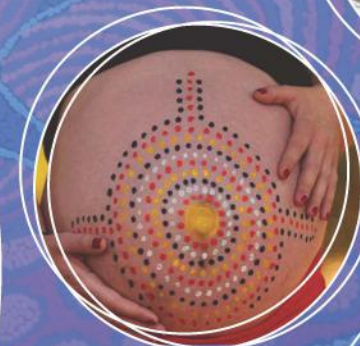
